We began in the spring with a massive cleanup of the destruction left behind by Super-storm Sandy. Fallen trees and a utility pole had to be removed, along with other debris and fallen electrical wires which were reinstalled underground.

The outside bar sustained roof damage that was repaired. We are now ready to begin normal spring cleanup out back. In addition to the roof repair, the outside bar received some TLC. The outside walls to the snack bar were painted, and the flower beds cleaned up. By Memorial Day, we were ready for the summer season.

Over the summer, the card room received a much needed facelift. The walls were painted and new ceiling tiles and carpeting were installed. We then tackled the inside bar. New ceiling tiles were installed, walls painted and a new floor installed. The green carpeting wrapped round the bar itself was replaced with ceramic tile. New bar stools are now in place, and three 60" TV's replaced the old sets we had.

With the help of the Columbiettes the ladies room by the front entrance received a makeover. The walls were painted, new ceiling tiles installed, and the ceramic tile floor was laid down. Come 2014, our focus will be the hall. Details to follow.
