KNIGHT OF THE MONTH APRIL 2016

Chuck Cababe



When one thinks of the food drives which have been held at the Union Knights of Columbus during the past few years, the one name that comes to mind is that of Chuck Cababe. No brother has exhibited such a commitment and concern for helping with the council's food drives as Chuck.

I first saw Chuck and his wife serving at St. Antonius Church in Newark when I visited that church on a few occasions and little did I know at that time that a few years later we would be brother Knights at Union 4504.

According to Chuck's wife: Ask Chuck Cababe what he thinks is most important to him and he will tell you this:

"For me to do the will of our Lord, Jesus, and to serve my family and community." She adds that Chuck is passionate about living out his faith with his family and in feeding the poor.

Chuck's life shows that he does just that. His faith journey began as an altar server in St. James, Basking Ridge, NJ. He became a lector at the age of 14 and continued that ministry as he earned his finance degree from Seton Hall University in 1983. He currently lectors at St. Michael's. He married his wife and faith partner, Joyce, in 1990. Together they served the Lord in teaching catechism and attending pro-marriage seminars. When they became parents in 1999, Chuck lead his family in faith with nightly prayer and music, (he plays the guitar) and helping at the food pantry at St. Mary's, Elizabeth. Chuck's son, Phillip, is a lifeguard with the swim club.

Chuck became a Knight at Council 4504 in 2003. His passion for feeding the poor has led him to run several food drives from 2004-2007, and again in 2015 to present. Chuck has expanded the Knights of Columbus' food drive by collaborating with The Gateway Family YMCA, Union, in their Togetherhood Initiative, where YMCA members donated food for the Council's drive. Chuck was also instrumental in organizing a discussion meeting last November at which brothers were addressed by Christopher Bell, co-founder and Executive Director of Good Council Homes, about the programs and activities of that organization.

Chuck's fervor in sharing the love of God with his brothers and community, inspired him to become the spokesperson for the Catholic Men's Conference held each March. At home, Chuck enjoys romantic getaways with his wife and outdoor trips with his son. He works hard as a comptroller for Patel Consultants Corp. He shows no signs of stopping his work in serving the Lord.
